2018.01	DDMC-3871	When upgrading or un-installing DDM Action Server Clients, force a task kill on DDMActionServerClient.exe after stopping service, to ensure all processes are stopped and files upgraded / removed.
2018.01	DDMC-4963	2.4.3 Creo Parametric Step Files
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5761</u>	The ability to choose multiple decision makers, when sending to a workflow decision step defined as 'Choose on send' and with 'Individual selection' enabled.
2018.01	DDMC-5762	Using workflow custom xml, an option to default / determine the decision (multiple) makers on the destination decision step, based on folder attribute selections.
2018.01	DDMC-5776	New DDM Administration Page System Access -> Profiles
2018.01	DDMC-5904	A warning prompt when logging into DDM Office, if the user is a member of the Admin group.
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5930</u>	The ability to set a default numbering system to be used for items when created, unless an alternate numbering is selected by the user.
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5931</u>	When dropping onto a folder from the file system, with option to "choose folder on creation" enabled, the folder should be defaulted to the folder instead of prompting.
2018.01	DDMC-5932	An option to 'Prompt for Properties, when dragging files onto DDM' (Tools - Options - Import).
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5933</u>	On state change of an item, checks to verify all required attributes have values set and if not, prevent change of state.
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5934</u>	To be able to modify Description attribute (for folder or item) (ACL permission allowing) directly from the Search results / Folder Contents.

2018.01	DDMC-5972	For newly created attributes in PARTS, DOCS and DRAWINGS Page should be Custom.
2018.01	<u>DDMC-5989</u>	When drag/dropping items into DDM, the search results to (optionally) be updated to list those new items.
2018.01	DDMC-6006	Administration -> Users should have Profile Name column
2018.01	DDMC-6007	Administration - Profiles to see list of users using profile
2018.01	DDMC-6009	Replication performance can be poor when replicating to a VM
2018.01	<u>DDMC-6014</u>	An additional Folder link attribute option against 'Link Update' or 'Update by State' to allow replacement only at certain state(s).

2018.01	DDMC-6019	Override option to force all emails to send from the 'System From' email address.

2018.01	PINV-220	When loading models into Inventor, if models are dirtied during load (e.g. parameter updates, rebuild, etc.) then do *not* automatically save as this may hide changes to assemblies.
2018.01	PS-396	When performing Save-As from SolidWorks to DDM on a model and including drawings, drawings renamed to match the new model names before prompting for new drawing properties.
2018.01	PS-407	Support for SolidWorks 2018.
2018.01	PS-409	When saving large assemblies from SolidWorks to DDM, it can be very time consuming as the assembly components are resolved from large-assembly mode and needs speed optimisation.
2018.01	PS-415	Using SolidWorks PDMIntegrator, the messagebox questions and warnings displayed are not always maintained on top of the SolidWorks app and allow SolidWorks to sit on top.
